

IMPORTANT TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED THROUGH OPEN ENROLLMENT



District 54 will provide free bus transportation for students who live 1.5 miles or more from the open enrollment school they attend or live within an area that the Illinois Department of Transportation has determined to be a safety hazard (such as when students would have to cross a busy road). Students enrolled in the English-Spanish dual-language program must attend their dual base school and meet the above criteria to qualify for free transportation.

Bus registration forms will be sent to families the second week of June and must be returned by the end of June. Bus stops will be community stops based on the addresses on the registration forms we receive. If you do not return the form, no transportation will be arranged.

If you live less than 1.5 miles from the open enrollment school your child attends, you may apply for paid transportation. Application forms will be sent to families the second week of June. Community bus stops will be based on the addresses on the applications returned by July 15, if transportation fees have been paid in full. Annual fees for the 2021-22 school year are as follows (the School Board has not yet approved the 2022-23 fees).

Sign up on or before July 15 to receive a \$50 early-bird discount of

- \$475 for one child,
- \$600 for two children or
- \$700 for three or more children.

After July 15, the annual fees are

- \$525 for one child,
- \$650 for two children or
- \$750 for three or more children.
